## **FSF 1D Academic French**

This course emphasizes the development of oral communication as well as consolidation of reading and writing skills. Listening skills are developed by watching popular films “en français”. Grammatical structures and vocabulary are also practised while exploring a variety of themes such as friends, mysteries, monsters, time travel and animals.

## **FSF 1P Applied French**

This course emphasizes the development of oral communication skills which will be integrated with reading and writing. Students are encouraged to understand and speak French through conversations and presentations as well as brief descriptions, dialogues and presentations. Listening skills are developed by watching popular films “en français”.

## **FSF 2D - Grade 10 French**

(Prerequisite FSF 1D)

This course continues to emphasize the development of written communication skills and creativity through the creation of a menu, newspaper page and advertisements. Listening skills are developed by watching popular films “en français”. Oral practice includes dialogues and classroom presentations. Cajun, Creole and French cultures are discussed.

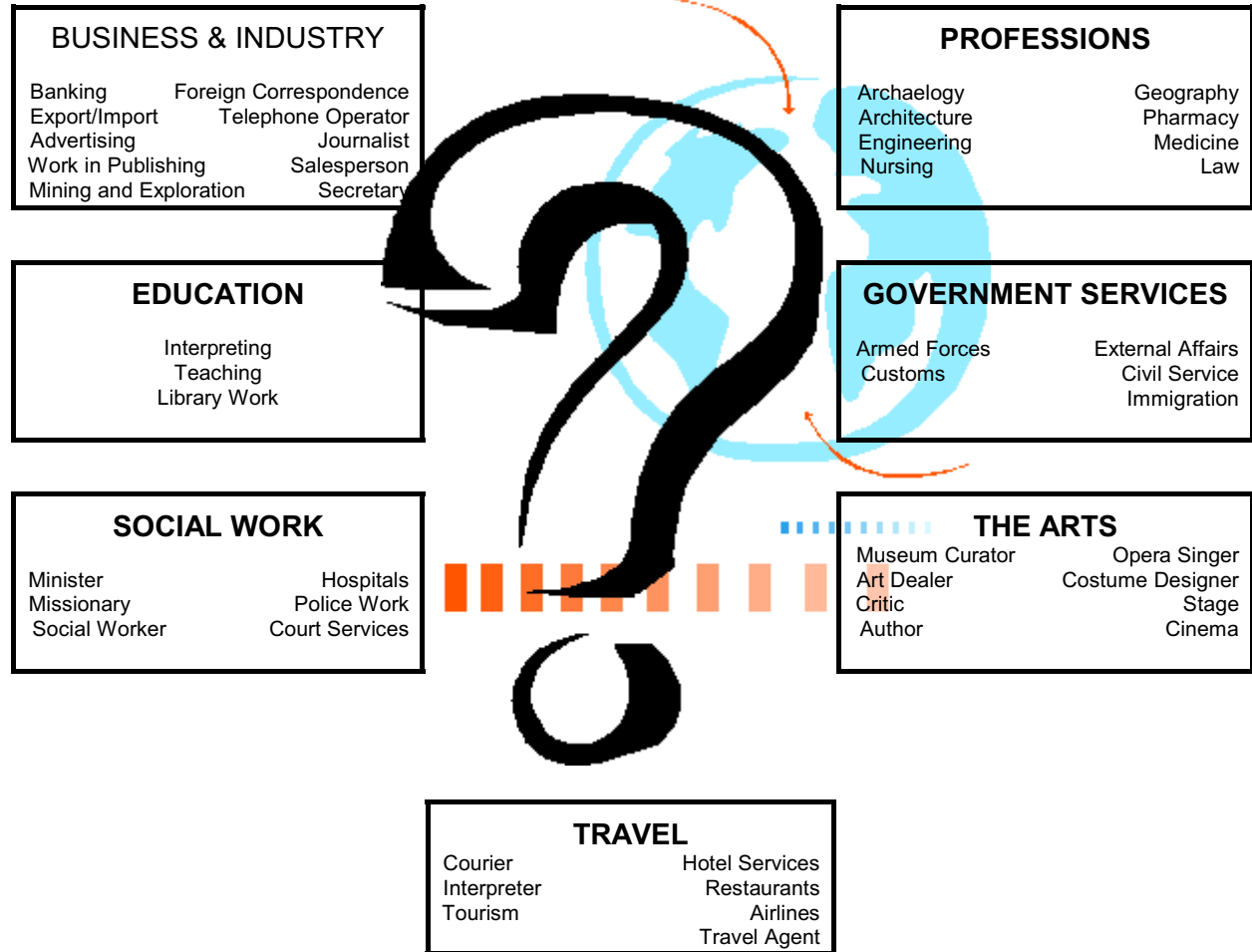
